

**Pucketts Manor
Pool Rules and Regulations**

1. Pool Hours: 9:00AM to 9:00PM, 7 days a week
2. **NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
3. **All members are advised to familiarize their children with all pool rules. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children under all circumstances.**
4. The gate to the pool area must be closed and locked at all times. If you are the last person leaving the pool, please make sure all doors and gates are secured
5. **This is a family environment and appropriate swimming attire is required. No cutoffs permitted.**
6. No glass containers, breakable containers, or chewing gum allowed in the pool area.
7. For safety reasons the following activities are prohibited:
 - a. Running
 - b. Pushing
 - c. Jumping on others
 - d. Spitting
 - e. Nose blowing in the pool
 - f. Dunking or holding others under water
 - g. Diving
8. In the event of thunder and lightning, all members/ guests must evacuate the pool area.
9. In accordance with health department requirements:
 - a. Proper swimwear is required at all times.
 - b. Swimming with contagious disease or infectious conditions, including blisters or cuts is prohibited.
 - c. All children not toilet trained must wear plastic, water tight diaper covers (rubber pants) **AND** swim diapers. If your child has an "accident". **DO NOT USE THE SHOWERS TO CLEAN THEM UP!** The shower floors are not designed for this type of use. This is a safety hazard and is almost impossible to sanitize.
 - d. Showering after heavy perspiration is required before entering the pool.
10. **No children under 16 years of age are permitted to enter the pool area without a parent or guardian present**
11. Children are not allowed to use the shower facilities or spend excessive time in the restrooms without parental supervision.
12. **Radios, CD players, phones and personal music devices are required to use headphones. In order not to disturb your neighbors.**
13. No pets, bicycles, skateboards, skates or other vehicles are allowed in the pool area.
14. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.
15. **No food is permitted within 6 feet of the pool edge. Please do not take food past the Cabana! No drinks are allowed in the pool.**
16. All trash must be placed in trash receptacles provided.
17. Reservation of pool chairs and tables when not in the pool area is prohibited.
18. The pool furniture is not to be used outside the pool area.
19. The pool furniture must be moved by picking it up rather than dragging it from one place to another. Moved pool furniture must be picked up and returned to its original location after use.
20. Umbrellas must be put down at all times, when not In use.
21. Tables must be cleaned/wiped down after use.

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22. Water wings, children's small floats, snorkel tubes, face masks, kick boards, flippers, and "nerf" type balls under 12" in diameter are permitted. Other flotation devices will be permitted based upon occupancy of the pool. **No oversized floats are permitted!**
23. A member must accompany guests while they are using the pool. Maximum number of non-resident guests is 6.
24. The pool and surrounding area may not be reserved for exclusive use.
25. The pool is to be used exclusively for Pucketts Manor members and their accompanied guests. Giving out the FOB to anyone other than members is prohibited and will result in loss of pool use for the year.
26. Only paid residents in good standing are considered members. Unpaid residents or residents not in good standing may not be considered guests and are not permitted to use the pool.
27. No alcoholic beverages are allowed for anyone under the age of 21. If consuming alcohol, discretion should be used and containers concealed. Alcohol brought into the pool area by members and guests should be for personal use only. Remember, no glass containers.
28. In using the pool, members and guests must be considerate of others enjoying the facility. Examples of behavior that would interfere with the enjoyment of the facilities by others include exuberant / boisterous play, use of abusive language, apparent intoxication or destruction of property. Individuals engaged in this type of behavior are subject to expulsion from the pool area.
29. The health and safety of members and their guests are ultimately their own responsibility. In using the pool, members and guests assume all liability. The Pucketts Manor Homeowners Association assumes no responsibility or liability for anyone using the pool. This includes the loss or damage of personal property while at or using the pool.
30. These rules are designed to ensure a safe and enjoyable recreational experience for all members and their guests. In addition, these rules are designed to protect the assets of the community for which all Pucketts Manor residents are ultimately financially responsible. Violation of these rules, therefore, cannot be allowed. Enforcement of these rules is the responsibility of all members. Repeated rule breaking will be escalated to the Pucketts Manor Board of Directors for disciplinary action as required to ensure compliance. Infraction of any pool rule may result in fines and suspension of pool privileges at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
31. One FOB will be issued to each Household.
32. In Case a FOB is lost or damaged, please contact the HOA via the website www.Puckettsmanor.com to report it. A replacement FOB can be programmed and attained for a replacement fee of \$10.00.
